items that must be corrected as soon as possible, but completed no later than March 20, 2004. Please remember the public is able to see the cabins/winter quarters everyday. This is why the camps and cabins/winter quarters must look correct for the Civil War period. This is first and foremost a tourist site. And it is also our "home". Please remember to pick up any trash bags, cans, bottles etc! Thank you for your help.

1. Billy Smith/Tommy Mullin cabin. Needs new canvas roof.

2. 1st Texas cabins - need to be rebuilt, repaired or torn down.

3. 6th Va. Winter Quarters. Cover up and hide rolled tin roof anywhere the public can see it, both inside and out. Tin was used, but not the rolled gutter type.

4. Ray Steveson winter quarters. Clean up around it.

5. Billy Crittenden/ Bill Kerr cabin - Repair or take down.

6. Derrick Gonzalo - Repair or take down.
